




Item No. 54-5.2: To consider the adoption of Special Provisions for Procurement of Scientific Equipment and Consumables.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the adoption of Special Provisions for Procurement of Scientific Equipment and Consumables in line with the Office Memorandum No. F.20/42/2021-PPD dated 05.06.2025 prescribing special provisions under General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017 to facilitate smoother procurement of scientific equipment and consumables for research purposes by Scientific Ministries/ Departments.

Item No. 54-5.3: To consider the recommendations of the committee constituted for determining retention policy & scrap / residual values of laptop / tablet / similar devices / computing items.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the recommendations of the committee constituted for determining retention policy & scrap / residual values of laptop / tablet / similar devices / computing items, as per the following:

- The device shall be the property of the institute for up to 4 years from the date of purchase. The officer concerned will be at liberty to get the device insured at his/her personal cost.
- Post completion of the useful life of a device in case of laptops/notebooks and similar devices, the faculty member/eligible officer shall retain the device. (≥ 4 years in present case of laptop/tablet and similar devices).
- The depreciation on a linear scale and useful-lifetime for laptops/tablets, as well as other computing devices (Desktop computers/workstations) is attached as Annexure-A



Item No. 54-5.4: To consider revision in rate of House Rent Allowance (HRA) of Ph.D. students with Institute Assistantship.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the revision in rate of House Rent Allowance (HRA) of Ph.D. students with Institute Assistantship as proposed from 16% to 20 %.

Parmeshwar Jhanwar. The effective date of upgradation will be from the date of recommendation of DPC or from the date of eligibility (whichever is later).

The expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid, and in case the grant-in-aid is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG.


Item No. 54-5.10: To consider the proposal of upgradation of classroom interiors including miscellaneous civil work and furniture installation in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the preliminary estimate of ₹5,41,79,766/- for upgradation of classroom interiors including miscellaneous civil work and furniture installation in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur. The expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid, and in case the grant-in-aid is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG.

Item No. 54-5.11: To consider the proposal for smart classroom facilities in six lecture halls having 250 seating capacity in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the preliminary estimate of ₹6,31,00,412/- for smart classroom facilities in six lecture halls having 250 seating capacity in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur. The expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid, and in case the grant-in-aid is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG.

Item No. 54-5.12: To consider the proposal for providing Audio- Video system with smart podium in 42 lecture halls having 126 seating capacity in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur.



The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the preliminary estimate of ₹9,60,01,751/- for providing Audio- Video system with smart podium in 42 lecture halls having 126 seating capacity in VLTC at MNIT Jaipur. The expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid, and in case the grant-in-aid is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG.

Item No. 54-5.13: To consider the proposal for extending the Old Pension Scheme to employees of the institute regularized pursuant to the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Judgement in Secretary, State of Karnataka vs. Uma Devi (2006)

The FC deliberated in detail on the proposal regarding the extension of the Old Pension Scheme to employees whose services were regularized pursuant to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Secretary, State of Karnataka vs. Uma Devi. After careful consideration, the FC observed that the said judgment cannot be generalized for extending the benefits of the Old Pension Scheme. Accordingly, the proposal was not agreed to and was declined.

Item No. 54-5.14: To consider empanelment of hospitals, Diagnostic centers, clinics and laboratories to provide services at CGHS rates to MNIT Staff, faculty members and their families.


Item No. 54-5.16: To consider the proposal for engagement of a "Media Relations Executive" on contractual basis.

The expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG, and in case the Institute IRG is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid.

Item No. 54-5.22: To consider the final construction cost of Rs. 5,67,85,767/- for construction of a 1 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) at MNIT Jaipur.

The FC considered and recommended to the Board for approval of the final construction cost of Rs. 5,67,85,767/- for construction of the 1 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant at MNIT Jaipur (excluding O&M) and to release the balance payment of Rs. 3,68,27,465/- to CPWD. The expenditure shall be met from the grant-in-aid, and in case the grant-in-aid is insufficient, the remaining expenditure shall be met from the Institute IRG.
